Job Description: Substance Abuse Counselor

Program/ Department: StarVista's DUI Program

Salary/Wage: DOE (depends on experience),

Status: 20 – 40 hour week, non-exempt (Bilingual Spanish Counselors required), Health Benefits and generous PTO package

REQUIREMENTS:

This position requires being available 2-3 nights a week and the ability to facilitate First Offender Drinking and Driving Program in addition to outpatient substance abuse groups (proposition 36, deferred entry of judgment & outpatient treatment). A California Alcohol & Drug Counseling Certification or a minimum of a Masters degree is required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Certification as an Alcohol and Drug Counselor; able to pass fingerprint clearance; ability to facilitate and counsel adults in a group setting; chart individual files as required by Title 9, Chapter 3, California Code of Regulations; flexible evening and weekend schedule.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: Provides court-mandated education and counseling for adults convicted of domestic violence offences, drug possession, being under the influence of illegal drugs, or driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Participants learn about addiction, anger management, stress management and communication, as well as the legal and social consequences of their actions.
