JOB REQUIREMENTS:

This unique opportunity allows you to be a part of a strong clinical team comprised of diverse clinicians who are all working under the leadership of a program manager who is passionate about building strong clinical skills and strong teams as well as serving the underserved individuals in our county. You will provide outpatient mental health services and support to individual adults, couples, families, children and adolescents in our community. Conduct individual and family psychotherapy sessions and provide ethical and high quality services. Participate fully as a staff member with the Counseling Center, Clinical Services Team, and within StarVista, and collaborate with other staff in the coordination of ethically appropriate, theoretically sound, culturally informed, and holistic interventions to address client issues and enhance client and family member strengths. Skilled in maintaining positive relationships and collaborating with other systems, including parents, school, probation, CPS, and other programs. Maintain a minimum caseload of 15 clients (majority of caseload will consist mainly of monolingual Spanish-speaking Medi-Cal clients). Maintain up-to-date files and required paperwork, data entry, and required documentation, including Medi-Cal Billing and Counseling Center documentation.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

A Master's or Doctorate degree in Social Work, Psychology, or Counseling from an accredited program, and a registered Intern with the California Board of Behavioral Sciences, CAPIC, or BOP. Demonstrable and verifiable skills, abilities, and qualities commensurate with specific position requirements. Licensed or license eligible (Supervision for licensing available). Two years of clinical or relevant experience with children, adolescents, adult or families and outside systems required. Oral fluency in Spanish is required.
