BRIDGES

StarVista's Bridges is an intensive, outpatient day treatment program focused on supporting alcohol and drug offenders who are incarcerated. The goal of Bridges is to help individuals end the cycle of substance abuse and crime. In San Mateo County, successful completion of the Bridges Program will satisfy a mandate from the Court to enter and complete a residential treatment program as a condition of probation.

Bridges' intensive approach to

treatment requires small caseloads and strong environmental controls such as drug testing and electronic monitoring. The program's effectiveness relies on the commitment of both staff and participants to this one-year program.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

- Must be eligible for probation in San Mateo County
- Must have a history of alcohol and drug dependency
- Must have no more than one current pending or one prior conviction involving sale or possession of controlled substance for sale
- Must have no more than one current pending or one prior conviction for a misdemeanor crime of violence
- Must not be required to register as a sex or gang registrant (as a result of current or past criminal history).
