Job Description: Floating/Relief Substance Abuse Counselor for Archway/Pacifica DUI

REQUIREMENTS:

This position requires being available for relief work with the ability to facilitate First/Multiple Offender Drinking and Driving Program in addition to outpatient substance abuse groups (deferred entry of judgment & outpatient treatment). Registration in a California Alcohol & Drug Counseling Certification Program, or Completed Certification in a California Alcohol & Drug Counseling Program or a minimum of a Masters degree is required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Registration/Certification as an Alcohol and Drug Counselor or a Masters degree, and an ability to pass fingerprint clearance; ability to facilitate and counsel adults in a group setting; chart individual files as required by Title 9, Chapter 3, California Code of Regulations; flexible evening schedule.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: Provides court-mandated education and counseling for adults convicted of domestic violence offences, drug possession, being under the influence of illegal drugs, or driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Participants learn about addiction, anger management, stress management and communication, as well as the legal and social consequences of their actions.
