CHILD AND PARENT SERVICES

Now serving children ages 0-17 and their families in San Mateo County that have been victim of child abuse and/or neglect.

The program provides therapeutic and advocacy services to children victimized by abuse and/or neglect using a short-term approach. Services for family members and/or caregivers of child victims are also available to help with the treatment of the child.

Prevention Early Interventions services are still available to families with children 0-17 in selected cities across San Mateo County. Services are available in the family's home, in their community, or telehealth. Range of services includes:

- Individual, child and family therapy
- Family Advocate-Case Management services (skill building, connection to resources)
- Parent education
- Parent support groups/workshops in the community.
