## **CHANGING LIVES SPEAKERS**

#### **ERIC WOLLMAN**

#### Retired Police Chief, Burlingame

Eric Wollman has been a StarVista Board Member since 2016. He has 36 years of law enforcement service in San Mateo County, and recently retired as the Chief of Police for the City of Burlingame. Eric has supported the mission of StarVista throughout his entire career. He continues to share his understanding, advocacy, and appreciation of StarVista's services with many people in and outside of his profession.

#### **CONGRESSMAN KEVIN MULLIN, CA 15**

Kevin Mullin, a 4th-generation Californian and San Mateo County native, is representing CA-15 in the U.S. House of Representatives. He has a passion for civic engagement and democracy, having learned early that active participation in the political process gives a voice in local, state, and federal government. Kevin has served as a member of the City of South San Francisco City Council and as the longest tenured Speaker pro Tem in the California State Assembly. Kevin is a champion for climate resiliency, having been part of the architects of the \$3.7 billion climate resilience package and worked on creating San Mateo County's One Shoreline. He has also served as an aide to his political mentor, former Congresswoman Jackie Speier, and has been a local small communications business owner and television host and commentator. Mullin holds a master's degree from San Francisco State University and studied leadership at Harvard's Kennedy School of Government.

#### SARA LARIOS MITCHELL, Ph.D., MACP

StarVista Chief Executive Officer

Sara Larios Mitchell was appointed CEO of StarVista in October 2012. She has a master's in counseling psychology from Golden Gate University and a doctorate in transpersonal psychology from the Institute of Transpersonal Psychology. With over 15 years of experience in clinical services including early childhood, domestic violence, trauma, youth development, family support, and counseling, Sara is strongly committed to the children, families, and individuals in our diverse community, and to strengthening opportunities for everyone to transform their lives.

#### JERRY MOE, MA

#### Founder of StarVista's Kids Kamp

Jerry Moe, MA, is the Senior Clinical Advisor at the National Association for Children of Addiction (NACoA). He is the National Director of Children's Programs, Emeritus, at Hazelden Betty Ford. Jerry is an author, speaker and consultant on issues for children and families hurt by addiction. He has spent over four decades working in the treatment and recovery worlds, including establishing StarVista's The Children's Place and Kids Kamp programs. Among his two dozen books are *Through a Child's Eyes: Understanding Addiction and Recovery* and the *Beamer Series* for kids. Jerry's work is featured in the PBS documentary Lost Childhood and Emmy Award winning programs on both Nickelodeon and Sesame Street.









#### MARILYN THOMAS. PH.D., MPH

#### StarVista Board Member

Marilyn D. Thomas is a social epidemiologist investigating structural racism as a social determinant of health. Born and raised in San Francisco's Bavview/Hunters Point District. Marilyn's parents struggled with addiction which left her homeless at the age of 15. Forced to support herself, she entered the Daybreak Program at age 17 and gained permanent housing after 6 months. Since then, Marilyn has earned her bachelor's degree in microbiology and master's in public health from SFSU, and her Doctorate in Epidemiology from UC Berkeley. As a Postdoctoral Fellow at UCSF, her research involves integrating social theory and examining the intersections of race, socioeconomic position, and environmental factors using advanced causal inference methods and novel study designs.




## **ROUND UP YOUR MACY'S PURCHASE**
